





# JADA BABY SHOES

#### FINISHED SIZE: US BABY'S 1-5

Jada Baby shoes are THE shoes for you and your child's fancy day in the house. Due to the elastic heel you don't need to worry about the shoes from falling off the child's foot! Utilizing solid colored fabric can help the shoes to look more simple and casual. Start these adorable pair of shoes TODAY & make a matching pair with the little one! Designer's Review

#### MATERIAL LIST

#### **FABRIC**

44" wide heavyweight home decorator or quilting weight cotton

- (1/4) Yard for exterior fabric
- (1/4) Yard for lining

#### **INTERFACING**

(1/4) Yard of 44" wide light or medium weight fusible interfacing

#### NOTE:

- \* No seam allowance is needed for the interfacing
- \*\*Non-skid soles and other non-skid materials are recommended for the exterior sole piece
- \*\*\*CAUTION: Small children may choke on beads, buttons, and other small pieces if they come loose

#### **OTHERS**

(1) Spool of coordinating thread 6" of ¼" width elastic band

#### TOOL LIST

Ruler, Scissors, Chalk pencil, Pencil, Sewing machine, Pins, Needle, Shape tool

- \* Seam allowance 1/4" unless otherwise specified.
- \* All units are in inches.

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#### **Cut out the Fabric**

Draw the patterns directly onto the wrong side of a single layer of fabric. Because there is a right and left shoe you will need to reverse the sole pattern when tracing. Make sure the right and left pieces are separated to avoid confusion when attaching the soles. Cut out the exterior, lining, and interfacing. Fuse the interfacing on the wrong side of the lining following the manufacturer's guide.

#### **EXTERIOR**

- (2) Upper Pieces
- (4) Ruffle Pieces
- (2) Sole Pieces
- (2) Strap Pieces

Size 1, 2 : 3/4" Width X 4" Height Size 3, 4, 5: 7/8" Width X 5" Height

(2) Ribbon Pieces

Size 1, 2 : 1 1/2" Width X 4" Height Size 3, 4, 5: 1 1/2" Width X 3 3/4" Height

(2) Bow Pieces

Size 1, 2 : 1 1/2" Width X 1 1/2" Height Size 3, 4, 5: 1 1/2" Width X 1 1/2" Height

#### LINING

- (2) Upper Pieces
- (2) Sole Pieces

#### **INTERFACING**

(No seam allowance is needed for the interfacing)

- (2) Upper Pieces
- (2) Sole Pieces

#### **OTHERS**

(2) 3" Length Elastic Band

### Make the Strap and Ruffle



**Picture 1** Fold the one side of strap 1/4" in lengthwise and press.



**Picture 3**Place the ruffle pieces right sides together. Pin and stitch together, leaving the bottom edge unstitched. Backstitch on both ends.



**Picture 2** Fold the other side of strap 1/4" and press again.



**Picture 4** Clip the corner seams.





**Picture 5** Trim the curved seam.



**Picture 6**Turn the ruffle piece right side out and press.
Repeat this process the other ruffle pieces.



**Picture 7**Place the ruffle onto the upper pieces. Pin and baste the raw seam of the frill onto the top of the upper.

Running stitch the ruffle. Then pull the ruffle to be about 3 1/2" long.



**Picture 9**Pin the ruffle onto the upper piece. Baste the two together.

Place the strap piece onto the upper piece as indicated on the pattern. Topstitch 1/8" away from the edges of the strap. Backstitch on both ends.



### **Make the Upper**

Fold the exterior upper pieces in half lengthwise with right sides together. Pin and sew the heels. Press the heel seams open. Sew the lining upper pieces in the same manner.

Pin the both upper pieces. Sew the two pieces together by sewing around the center hole in an oval shape. Do not sew the ruffle.

Turn it right side out and iron the assembled upper.

Cut out the elastic band according to the given length. Add a safety pin on the end.

Place the exterior upper piece on the lining upper piece with right sides together.

Clip the curved seam.

Sew the elastic band line as indicated on the pattern.

Insert the elastic band into the heel strap opening





**Picture 19**Sew the one end of the elastic band.

Pull it out through the other end of the heel strap opening so that it creates a frill. Sew the other end of the elastic band. Cut the leftover elastic band.

## Assemble the Upper and Sole Lining



**Picture 21**Place the lining upper piece and the lining sole with right sides together.



**Picture 22** Match their center points. Pin the toe and heel.



Then, pin around the rest of the sole, clipping the heel seam as needed. Sew around the sole. Repeat for the other shoe.



**Picture 24**Attach the exterior sole piece and the upper piece facing on the right side.



**Picture 25**Match their center points. Pin the toe and heel.
Then, pin around the rest of the sole, clipping the heel seam as needed.



Sew around the sole, leaving a gap for turning. Make sure all the layers are included and backstitch on both ends.





**Picture 27**Trim the seams. Turn the shoe right side out.

Pin and sew the opening. Backstitch both ends.
Attach the ribbon on top of the strap. See Appendix A.
Make the ribbon. Make the other shoe in the same manner.

### Appendix A. Make the ribbon



**Picture(Appendix) 1**Fold and press the ribbon piece in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Open the ribbon piece and fold each side of it in half.



Picture(Appendix) 3
Fold the ribbon in half and stitch as shown in Picture 3.



Fold and press along the center crease again with the sides tucked in. Topstitch 1/8" away from the seam.



Picture(Appendix) 4
Make the bow piece in the same manner as the ribbon piece. Then fold the bow piece around the middle of the ribbon piece. Stitch from the backside of the ribbon piece. See Picture 4. Cut the remainder of the bow piece.
