Apron Size(App): 20" wide X 19.5" tall (Upper Strap not included)

Materials

Exterior fabric: 44" wide heavyweight home decorator or quilting weight cotton

(1/2) Front and Back Piece-see cutting layout

(1/4) Upper Strap and Side Straps

Lining: 44" wide quilting weight cotton

(½) Front and Back Piece -see cutting layout

(1/8) Upper Strap -see cutting layout

Velcro: 3" (1" wide Velcro)

Tools List

Ruler, Scissors, Chalk pencil, Pencil, Sewing machine, Iron, Pins.

All units are inches

EXTERIOR

- (1) Front and Back Piece
- (1) Upper Strap Piece
- (2) Side Strap Pieces


LINING

- (1) Front and Back Piece
- (1) Upper Strap Piece


<u>VELCRO</u>

Cut out the fabric

Place the pattern pieces on the wrong side of the fabric as indicated on the CUTTING LAYOUT. Using a chalk pencil or marking pen, mark the pieces adding 1/4" seam allowance. Cut the pieces out.

Attach the Upper Strap and the Front and Back piece

Place the exterior upper strap piece and the front piece with RIGHT sides together. Pin and stitch together, back tacking on both ends. Press the seam toward the upper strap. Topstitch onto the upper strap piece, 1/8" away from the seam, press again. Repeat this step for the lining upper strap and the back piece.

Make the Side Strap

One edge of strap will be visible; to give it a nice finish, fold and press a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance at one end. Fold the strap in half lengthwise with the WRONG sides together and press a crease. Open the strap so that the wrong side will be visible. Then, fold each side of the strap inward toward the crease. Fold $\frac{1}{4}$ " again along the crease and topstitch $\frac{1}{8}$ " away from the seam. Place the side strap onto the exterior Apron and baste. Attach the other side strap.




Assemble the Exterior and the Lining

With RIGHT sides together, place the lining onto the exterior fabric. The side straps will be between the lining and the exterior. Pin and stitch the Apron, leave a 5" opening on the bottom for turning. Clip the rounded seam and corner seams. Turn it right side out and press flat.

Finish the Apron

Pin the opening. Topstitch all around the apron included upper straps.

Open the Velcro, position the one piece on the upper strap, and sew the Velcro as a rectangle shape. Back tack on both ends. Place the other piece of the Velcro onto the other side of the upper strap following the same way. Repeat this step for the side straps.

Front and Back Pieces

1/4- inch seam allowance needed Exterior fabric: 1 CUT Lining: 1 Cut

Strap: 3" wide X 8.5" tall

1/4- inch seam allowance **included**Exterior fabric: 2 CUT

Velcro: 1.5" wide X 1" tall CUT 2

1 set for side strap, 1 set for upper strap



Adding $\frac{1}{4}$ " can be very simple, tape 2 round pencils together, and trace the line of pattern with inner pencil, while outer pencil draws the $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

Draw the pattern as is and flip the pattern. Align the center which is the dotted line, draw the other half again.



Velcro

11 1/2"

Adding 14 " can be very simple, tape 2 round pencils together, and trace the line of pattern with inner pencil, while outer pencil draws the 14 " seam.

Upper Strap Piece 1/4- inch seam allowance needed

Exterior fabric: 1 CUT Lining: 1 Cut

Draw the pattern as is and flip the pattern. Align the center which is the dotted line, draw the other half again.

- ** When printing this pattern, please print it without any margins at actual size.
- ** After printing the pattern and taping the pieces together, please follow the reference the provided size guide (3" or 5").
- ** Patterns marked as A4 are for users who utilize the A4 standard paper size.
- ** If you experience that certain parts of the pattern are not printing, you should be able to ignore those near the edge/border. These are usually just guides & signs.
