



# The Angelina **Beach Dress**

What you need: 1 meter/yard of fabric

(jersey in one or two way

stretch)

I usually work with a medium weight cotton and lycra mix fabric. Don't use 100% cotton unless its fabulous quality as it will stretch and loose shape like a tired t-shirt.

### PDF Pattern:

Make sure press the option don't shrink to fit A4 size! This is very important otherwise the pattern will be too small!




## **Preparation:**


Join the pattern pieces. Use the little flowers as a guide if you are not sure. What has the same flowers goes together.


Cut out one front, one back and a facing for each.

This pattern is the basis for a lot of styles. In my You Tube tutorials you can see how to quickly alter the pattern for a new look. Sometimes just changing the fabric makes a huge difference.






































Place fabric on the fold
